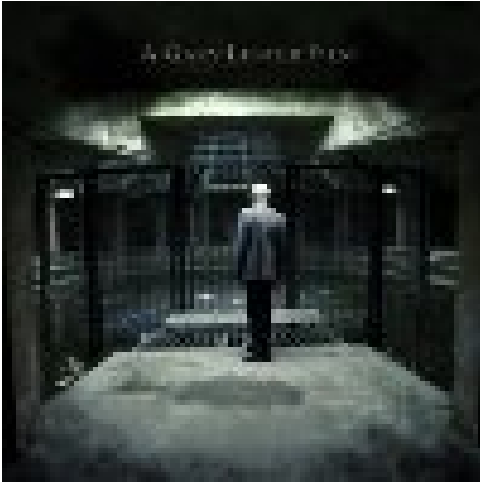


SAFE HAVEN- WARSAW ZOO- A Review
